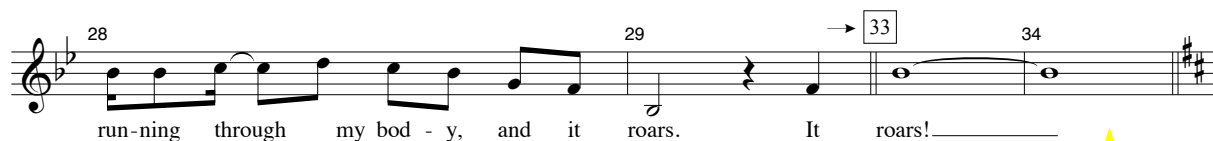

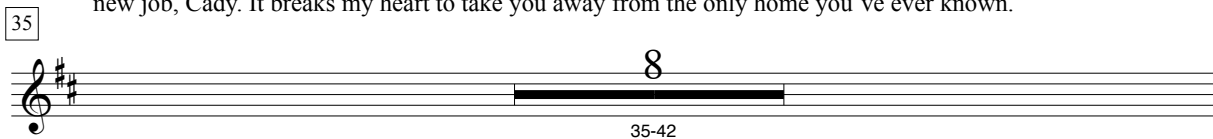

MRS. HERON: But the United States is so—

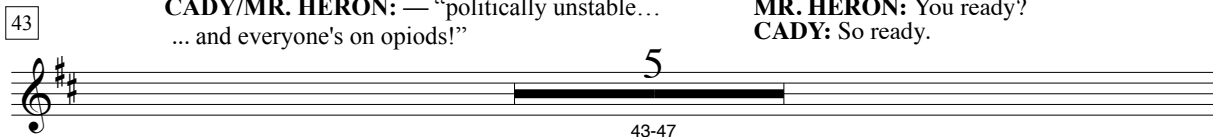
